

PSYCHOLOGY SUPERHERO ASSIGNMENT

Have you ever imagined what it would like to be a superhero? What would your powers be? What would be your weakness? What would your costume look like? Would you have a sidekick? Who would be your archenemy and why? For this assignment, you will answer these and other questions and at the same time, take a closer look at processes of the brain.

The Assignment:

Use your brain notes to help you create a psychology superhero/super villain. You must have:

1. **A title** – this will be your superhero's name and secret identity (i.e. – Amygdala Avenger.)
 2. **A picture** – A picture of your psychology superhero. If you are not artistic, you may use the drawing templates provided. You may also create your own entirely unique superhero. You may NOT just use an already existing superhero from comics, movies, or any other medium.
 3. **Super Power(s)** – What is your power or powers (relate to psychology/brain!!)? Ideally you should have at least one well-explained superpower.
 4. **Weakness(es)** – What is your kryptonite? Again you should have at least one weakness.
 5. **Sidekick(s)** – Who is your sidekick(s) and what do they do? Their powers are ideally related to the things that relate to your superhero's power.
 6. **Gadgets** – These should be brain-related things that you use to fight crime. **You should have at least one gadget.**
 7. **Arch Nemesis** – Who is your arch nemesis? Basis this person or persons on the things you can't stand about people. You may have an actual person in mind but **do NOT use their actual name or make them identifiable to the class.**
- Make sure to go over the list of requirements before you turn in your assignment!
 - A written explanation of your super hero must be included on the back of the assignment.
 - It goes without saying that anything on your assignment should be school appropriate and not embarrassing to anyone.
